Introduction

This release of HstEx® adds support for two browsers which have been designed for the security/privacy market, Avast Secure Browser and CCleaner Browser. We have also added support for seventy-four new versions of other browsers.

New Browser Support

We have added support for the following browsers:

Avast Secure Browser



Avast Secure Browser (previously Avast Safe-Zone) is a Chromium based web browser developed by Avast. Initially, the browser was available alongside Avast's paid versions of their Avast Antivirus software. However, as of March 2016, the company included the web browser as part of its free antivirus software.

The company describes the software as "a web browser with built-in security and privacy features to keep you safe online. It comes packed with all the tools you need to manage your online privacy, identity, and personal data."


We have added a Most Recently Used (MRU) drop-down list on the Open button so that the user can access previously saved session files.
